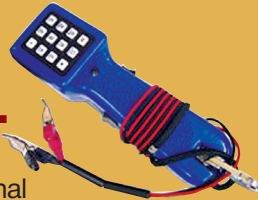

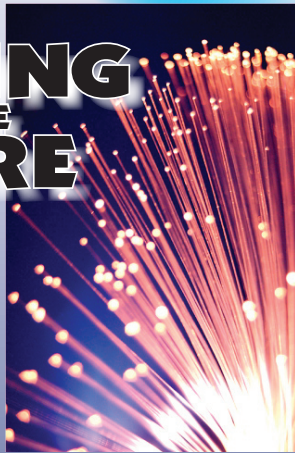

PLUMBER'S HELPER TRAINING PROGRAM

Our Plumber's Helper Training Program will train you to become a highly skilled laborer in this industry. Plumbers install, maintain and repair hot and cold water supplies, sanitation and waste disposal systems. They also work with oil, gas and solid fuel appliances, central heating systems & the National Plumbing Code.

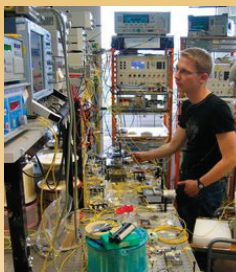


CERTIFIED FIBER OPTIC TECHNICIAN

The CFOT-301 (Certified Fiber Optic Technician) course is designed to provide experienced Telecommunications Technicians with the skills necessary to install, terminate, and most importantly splice, both single mode (SM) and multimode (MM) fiber optic cable. This short-term training program has been approved by the Fiber Optic Association, and is licensed by the New York State Education Department. Students who graduate from this program will not only receive a state approved completion certificate, but also an internationally recognized certification.

Topics Covered Include:

- Basics of Fiber Optics
- Fiber Optic Networks
- Fiber Optic Cables/Specs
- FOC Connectors and Splices (Mechanical)
- FOC Fusion Splicing
- OTDR Use and Testing
- Link Loss Budgets
- FOC Stripping, Cleaving and Polishing
- FOC Installation Procedures



Course Scheduling:

The course is 40 hours in duration, and is made up of both theory and laboratory training. Particular emphasis is placed on fusion splicing. QBITI currently uses both Fujikura and Sumitomo fusion splicers. Students will strip, cleave and splice both Single and Ribbon FOC and measure their work according to industry standards and tolerances. Classes meet week nights from Monday-Thursday, from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm, for 2 weeks; or on weekends from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm for 5 consecutive weekend days. Graduates must also pass online FOA administered test for certification.

ELECTRONIC/OFFICE MACHINE REPAIR TECH

We train you to become a Technician for the Electronic, Office Machine Field as a technician. You will be working on photo copiers, all-in-ones, laser printers and fax machines.

Once our course is completed you will be skilled to perform rough carpentry work, assist in finish work, repair remodeling and construction of buildings and fixtures, concrete construction, lock and door closer repair, laying linoleum, assist in the installation and repair of piping for water, gas, steam, vacuum and installation of irrigation and electric lines. Graduates are eligible for P-99 referral to the FDNY.
