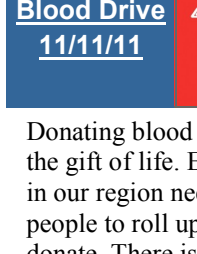

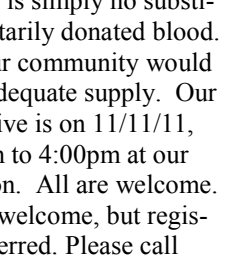
Building Maintenance Students Build Free Houses

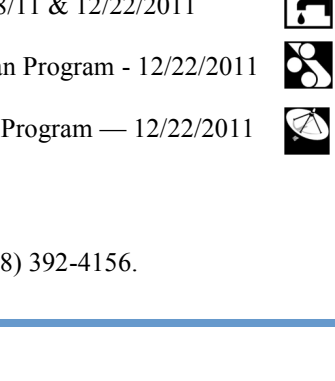

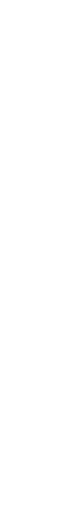
Placement Highlights

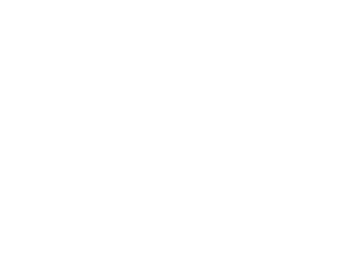
