

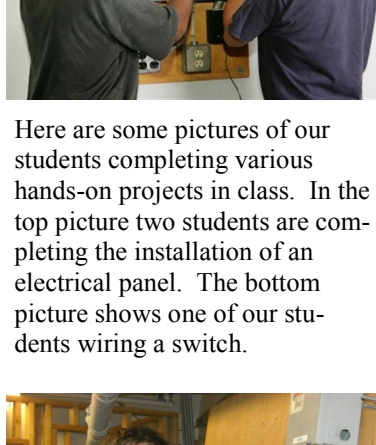

## [Focus on:](#) Electricians Helper Training Program

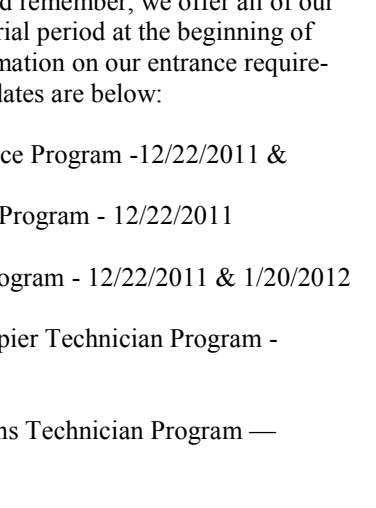
