### **BREAKING NEWS!** QBITTI Renews Its Lease In LIC, And Adds New Shop Space

QBITTI just renewed its lease with 33-00 Partners LLC. for our current location. The new lease extension is for 10 years, and adds more than 1,100 square feet of dedicated shop area to our existing space. Over the next few months QBITTI will be undergoing and extensive retro-fit of our school location. The "build-out" will include the aforementioned shop area, increasing the amount of space dedicated for the Student Resource Room/Library, creating another classroom for lectures, moving the administrative and admissions spaces to a new location, and moving the student lunchroom.

The addition of the new shop area is a result of our continuing efforts to provide the best and most cost efficient training programs to our clients, and their sponsoring organizations. We appreciate your comments, and have acted accordingly. The new shop will have permanent stand alone building mock-ups, a separate mechanical room for larger equipment and building supply storage, and the entire area will be a designated construction safety area (Hardhats and Safety Goggles).

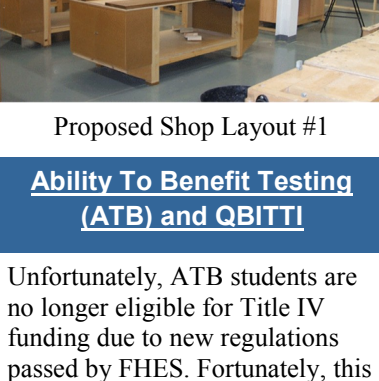
